

## Dossier:

### [Mas Amedda](#)

Mas Amedda served as the Grand Vizier of the Galactic Empire post-proclamation of the New Order and is a capable Chagrian politician. He also served as the Vice Chair of the Galactic Senate until succeeded by Sheev Palpatine. Amedda's positive aspects include strong political skills and history within government as a trusted senator.

### [Gilad Pellaeon](#)

Gilad Pellaeon is a captain of the naval forces of the Galactic Empire and an Imperial officer. He additionally served as commanding officer of the *Harbinger* star destroyer and Grand Admiral Savit's Third Fleet. He was assigned to Grand Admiral Thrawn shortly before the Battle of Endor and has returned to Imperial Space aboard the ISD *Leveler*.

### [Rae Sloane](#)

Rae Sloane is a human naval officer for the Galactic Empire and currently commands the elite Titan Squadron. During the Battle of Endor, Sloane served as Vice Admiral of the Imperial Navy and eventually was granted the rank of Grand Admiral by Fleet Admiral Rax. Although there are conflicting accounts of what exactly happened during the battle many believe Sloane gave the order to retreat following the destruction of the Second Death Star leading some to view her as a traitor who fled instead of avenging her fallen Emperor.

### [Iden Versio](#)

Iden Versio is a human soldier, the daughter of high-ranking Imperial officer Garrick Versio, and she is a skilled pilot in the Galactic Empire's military. Her most notable position was Commander of Inferno Squad, the commando unit which infiltrated the Dreamers, conducted special operations on behalf of the empire, and participated in the Battle of Endor.

### [Garrick Versio](#)

Garrick Versio is a human member of the Imperial military and a high-ranking officer in the Imperial Special Forces. Versio was the founder and leader of the elite Inferno Squad, a team of highly trained commandos who carried out dangerous and sensitive missions on behalf of the Empire. Versio played a key role in the Battle of Endor; he commanded a ground assault on the forest moon of Endor, working to secure the shield generator that protected the second Death Star.

### [Gallius Rax](#)

Rax is a ruthless Imperial officer who rose through the ranks to become a key figure in the Galactic Empire. Rax was trained by Emperor Palpatine himself, and he possesses a deep loyalty to the Empire, yet is also shown to have his own agenda and personal motivations that he keeps hidden from even his closest allies. ### [Moff Gideon](#)

Moff Gideon is a high-ranking officer in the remnants of the Galactic Empire and a skilled strategist and fighter. Gideon possesses a formidable arsenal of weapons and technology, including a Darksaber, a unique black-bladed lightsaber that is a symbol of leadership among the Mandalorians.

### [Treuten Teradoc](#)

Isard played a major role in the defeat of the Rebel Alliance on the planet Hoth, coordinating the Imperial forces and personally leading the attack on the Rebel base.

### [Sate Pestage](#)

Pestage rose to prominence as a loyal servant of Emperor Palpatine, serving as one of his top advisors during the early years of the Galactic Empire. Pestage was known for his political savvy

and his ability to navigate the complex web of alliances and power struggles that characterized the Empire. He played a key role in the construction of the first Death Star, serving as one of the project's chief overseers and ensuring that the massive space station was completed on time and within budget. Pestage also played a role in the Imperial takeover of the planet Naboo, which was a key source of resources for the Empire.

### [Blitzer Harrsk](#)

he joined the ranks of the Galactic Empire, and he proved himself to be an expert military strategist. Due to his military talents, he was appointed as one of the twelve Grand Admirals created by Palpatine, although he was one of the least popular Grand Admirals, and did not attempt to curry favor with the Imperial moffs.

### [Ardus Kaine](#)

Kaine was a skilled military strategist and served as a High General in the Galactic Empire. Kaine was a controversial figure who played a significant role in several pivotal events in the Star Wars canon. During the Galactic Civil War, Kaine was one of the key architects of the Empire's military strategy. Kaine was widely respected within the Empire for his tactical genius. He was also feared by his enemies, who saw him as a cunning and unpredictable opponent.

### [Josef Grunger](#)

Lumiya was once a promising young recruit of the Rebel Alliance who was taken under the wing of Darth Vader after he discovered her latent Force abilities. Lumiya is a skilled fighter and strategist and is known for her use of a distinctive red lightsaber whip that she created herself.

She also had a talent for manipulating others, often using fear and intimidation to achieve her goals.

### [Ishin-II-Raz](#)

Ishin-II-Raz became a key figure in the Commission for the Protection of the Republic, a body of volunteers who offered their support to Chancellor Palpatine in whatever ways they could, including various types of rallies and resource drives, as well as lucrative schemes. II-Raz proved a formidable public speaker and became COMPOR's chief spokesman at a relatively young age. COMPOR was reformed and renamed the Commission for the Preservation of the New Order, which aimed to institutionalize discrimination and Human High Culture, mostly through means of propaganda. II-Raz was heavily involved in the establishment of COMPNOR, and was the driving force behind many of its core concepts. Palpatine recognized II- Raz's political prowess and made him one of his 12 grand admirals.

### [Afsheen Makati](#)

Afsheen Makati is one of twelve members of the Imperial Navy elevated to the rank of Grand Admiral by Emperor Palpatine during the New Year's Fete Week ceremony. Makati's service record was no more distinguished than numerous admirals in the Imperial Navy and his appointment was considered a surprise by many. In the final years of the Empire, Makati commanded the Imperial Star Destroyer, Steadfast.

### [Savan](#)

Niece of the former leader of the Black Sun, Savan is a trained criminal and carter boss who took over after the death of her uncle at the hands of Vader. While many others would blame Vader for her uncles death Savan welcomed it and took over the criminal organization. With Vader now dead and the Empire fracturing Savan is seeking to maintain the power that she was able to accumulate under Imperial rule.

### [Black Krrsantan](#)

A wookiee with the rare color, Krrsantan was a gladiator for many years and has tremendous experience with combat, tracking, and bounty hunting. While he often works jobs just for the money his alignment with the Empire is deeper and is rooted in his respect for Vader's strength. With Vader now gone Krrsantan seeks revenge on those he believes killed the one Imperial he respected.

### [The Twins](#)

The Twins are Hutt crime lords who are the cousins of Jabba The Hutt. When Jabba was killed by Luke Skywalker The Twins were both elated and infuriated. Having taken over Jabba's territory they are now seeking revenge on the one they feel killed their cousin and siding with the remnants of the Empire that allowed them to operate unchecked for years.
