[Gial Ackbar](#)

Admiral Gial Ackbar is a military leader and a member of the Mon Calamari species and is known for his strategic acumen and his bravery in battle. Ackbar was the commander of the Rebel Alliance fleet at the Battle of Endor, a major conflict that saw the destruction of the second Death Star and the defeat of the Galactic Empire. Mark Linth was a human male who served as a Rebel Alliance pilot during the Galactic Civil War. He was born on Corellia and joined the Alliance shortly after the Battle of Yavin. Linth was a skilled pilot and a natural leader. He was known for his bravery and willingness to take risks in order to complete his mission. He was also known for his loyalty to the Alliance and his comrades. Linth was a member of the elite Rogue Squadron, a group of starfighter pilots who were tasked with carrying out dangerous missions for the Alliance. became the leader of Team 19, reporting to Captain Qarl. By the time of the Battle of Hoth, he was in line for yet another promotion.

[Brooks Carlson](#)

Brooks Carlson was a Human male member of the Galactic Empire who defected to the Alliance to Restore the Republic during the Galactic Civil War along with another Imperial, Crix Madine. Carlson was hired as a scout for General Madine's Rebel commando unit, and also trained Corporal Dansra Beezer to serve in that profession. In the year 4 ABY, the Alliance decided to attack the Empire's second Death Star battle station in orbit over the Forest Moon of Endor. Carlson, by then a veteran scout and pathfinder with the military rank of sergeant, was part of a strike team sent to the moon to deactivate the SLD-26 planetary shield generator protecting the Death Star. The strike team managed to disable the shield generator, allowing Alliance starfighters to destroy the Death Star

[Mishowan Shigormallan](#)

Mishowan Shigormallan was a male Human native of the planet Yelsain. As a teenager, he joined a crew of cargo haulers. He was constantly being chased by the Imperials and decided to join the Alliance when he met a group of Alliance field agents. He completed his training in the Special Forces division and was put in the Pathfinders regiment. He quickly became a lieutenant, and he was transferred to Taskforce Shen. He led a Pathfinder platoon under the command of Major Mart Stevez

[Fisk Csino](#)

Major Fisk Csino was a member of the Alliance to Restore the Republic during the Galactic Civil War. Part of the Alliance Special Forces, he specialized as a Wilderness Fighter and was the veteran of a dozen campaigns in the Outer Rim Territories by 0 ABY. Assigned to command the Nishr Taskforce in the wake of the Nishr Suppression—a crackdown by Imperial forces on rebellious Nish on the planet Nishr in the Outer Rim—Csino led the unit throughout their campaign against the local Imperial garrison

[Dal Konur](#)

Dal Konur was a Force-sensitive male Human who fought for the Rebel Alliance and its successor, the New Republic, in the Galactic Civil War against the authoritarian Galactic Empire. While he has no formal training in the Jedi arts he does have tremendous potential.

[Din Djarin](#)

A proud Mandalorian and unwittingly a member of an extremist group known for never removing their armor in the presence of another, Djarin is only somewhat aligned with the goals of the New Republic. While he dislikes the Empire and is seeking for a way to protect himself and his covert, he does not seek to live under New Republic law, and its prohibitions on bounty hunting.

[Bo-Katan Kryze](#)

A proud warrior and former member of Death Watch, Kryze has been fighting for a strong independent Mandalore since before the Clone Wars and when the Republic turned to the Empire she began a campaign against them. Hunted by the Empire and hated by many Imperially aligned Mandalorians she is now one of the few survivors of the great purge of Mandalore and is fighting with both Imperial groups as well as other Mandalorians to claim her homeland.

[Sabine Wren](#)

Sabine was the daughter of Ursula Wren, the leader of a powerful clan on Mandalore, and a skilled fighter, tactician, and artist. She often left a signature on her work and developed a distinct mark which she would leave behind at the scene of certain rebel operations. Wren fought with the crew of the Ghost and served under Hera Syndulla, eventually finding the darksaber and fighting to free her home of Mandalore. After the battle of Lothal, Wren has been protecting Lothal and awaiting the return of Ezra Bridger and Ashoka Tano until now.
