Committee Background

TOPIC A: Stereotypical Barbie Gets Kidnapped

Topic Background

Questions to Consider

- 1. How can this committee develop a comprehensive plan that saves Barbie from her perpetrators?
- 2. Who might be the individuals or groups responsible for the kidnapping, and what are their motives?
- 3. How do authorities respond to the kidnapping—does the general public need to take matters into their own hands?
- 4. How can the committee eliminate fear amongst Barbieland residents in order to bring joy back to the streets?

TOPIC B: Ken Reestablishes the Patriarchy

Topic Background

Despite the Barbies working so hard to dismantle Ken's original patriarchy, the domination of men has come to power again. The Kens, often in the shadow of their Barbie counterparts, started to feel overlooked and unheard once again. Out of this growing dissatisfaction emerged the movement dubbed 'Kens Rule, Barbies Drool.' This campaign is led by the Kens who have refused to accept their forgotten roles any longer. They want to give themselves a more prominent place in society and they want to force Barbies out of their positions of power. They are challenging the strong societal belief that femininity means superiority and are advocating for the rise of masculinity as the superior conception. Alliances have shifted, and the once unshakable foundation of feminism is trembling.

Current Situation

Questions to Consider

- 1. How can the committee prevent future uprisings, especially considering that Barbie's last plan fell through?
- 2. In what ways can the committee ensure that the Kens feel more integrated and accepted in Barbieland?
- 3. How can the committee navigate the delicate balance between promoting equality and ensuring that power dynamics do not shift too drastically, causing further division and unrest?
- 4. What will you do to accommodate the Kens who might lose their new housing if you dismantle the patriarchy?

Character Dossier
